In this issue of the Bulletin, we tell you about the 2015 publishing program for The Canadian Abridgment products. As usual at this time of year, we provide you with planned reissues, the anticipated publishing schedule and an estimate of the prices of our Abridgment products in the upcoming year. The only major reconsolidations planned for 2015 will be for the Case Law Digest component of the Abridgment, and the Canada Statute Citations, Canada/International volumes.

We plan to reissue only one title of the Case Law Digests: Civil Practice and **Procedure**. We expect the reissue to comprise 28 volumes.

There have been significant changes to the Rules in several jurisdictions. We are updating the title to reflect those changes. The value of the Civil Practice and Procedure title will be significantly enhanced by this process.

The reconsolidation of the Canada/International volumes of the Canada Statute Citations is expected to comprise 24 volumes.
