Highlights:

In accordance with customer feedback, and to better reflect current research trends as researchers increasingly turn to online sources and away from print to maintain currency, certain print currency products will be discontinued in 2018. Specific information regarding these changes is noted below, under the appropriate product. Explanatory letters will accompany each product's final release.

The only major reconsolidation planned for 2018 will be for the Case Law Digests component of the Abridgment. We plan to reissue the following titles:

September Release (15 volumes)

- Aboriginal law
- Administrative law
- Evidence
- Health law

December Release (11 volumes)

- Religious institutions
- Remedies
- Restitution and unjust enrichment
- Securities
- Statutes

While we endeavour to provide you with the most accurate prices and publishing dates, it is not possible at this time to state with absolute certainty the number of volumes, month of publication, and price. All prices are estimates and may change. An outline of the 2018 program as it is currently planned follows, and we will keep you informed of any changes as the year unfolds.
