

Notes Report

CLX EXPORT STEPS

The Case Logistix Dashboard includes a notes report, but it will only provide all notes in a library. The info below allows you to uncomment different options for the report. To uncomment a line in SQL, you simply remove the 2 dashes from the start of the line. To comment out a line, you would add the 2 dashes back to the start of a line.

You can now run this report with any of the following options:

- 1 Remove line feeds, carriage returns and turn commas into semi colons
- 2 Get notes for just the documents in a Tag
- 3 Exclude Private notes
- 4 Exclude document level
- 5 Get notes created by a specific user
- 6 Get notes created in a date range

Select all of the text below and copy and paste into SQL Server Management Studio or into the Westlaw CaseLogsitix Administrator tool. You can save the results to a CSV file.
